MITCH NEELY

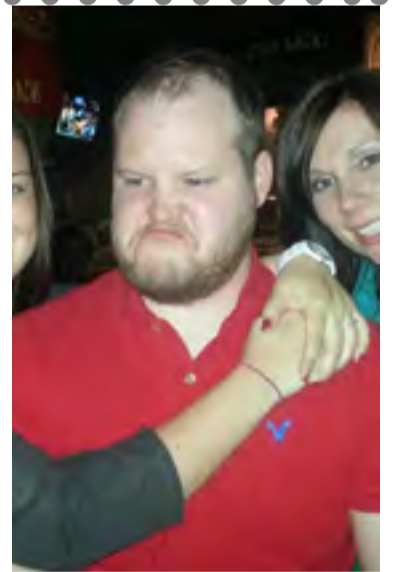

DRINKERS

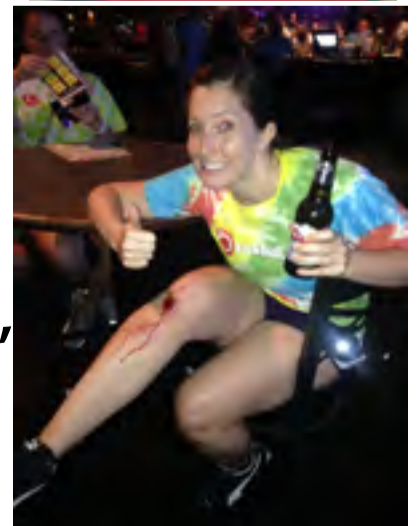
NATE ABBOT
